

PLI Minimum Grade Policy

Effective March 1, 2006, PLI is adopting a new minimum grade policy to encourage students to do their best academically. Following is the new standard:

Any student who does not earn a final grade of C- (64%) or above for any course will be required to re-take the course at a later date. Tuition fees for repeat classes will be \$100 per course per quarter.

Basically our thinking here is that if you're halfway paying attention, attending chats, and completing most of the assignments laid out in the syllabus, you will not have any trouble earning a final grade of C-. However, if distractions keep you from focusing on the subject matter, chatting, reading, or completing assigned projects, then you probably have not mastered the material sufficiently to meet the educational requirements for credentialing.
